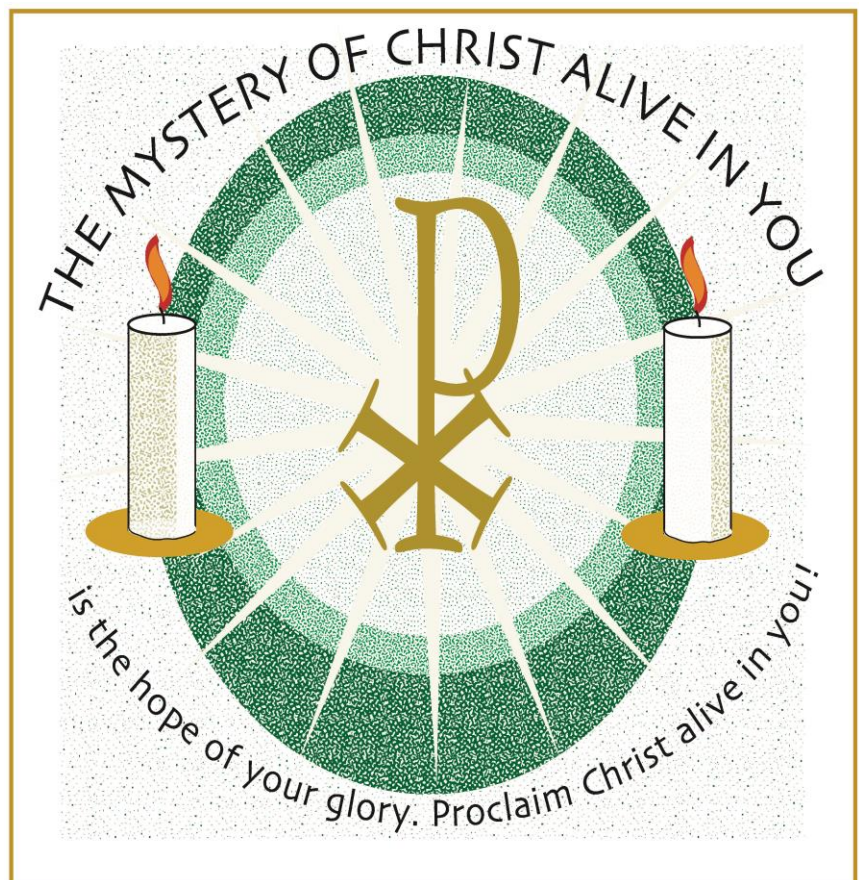
### Questions for personal reflection based on this Sunday's readings...

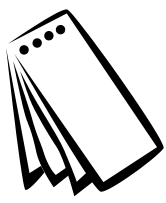
