Into whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this household.' If a peaceful person lives there, your peace will rest on him;


but if not, it will return to you. -Luke 10:2-5

This training is especially recommended for all of our ushers, ministers, and anyone who may be in a situation where CPR would be beneficial. Although this is not for certification, participants will receive the necessary training needed to perhaps one day help to save a life.
