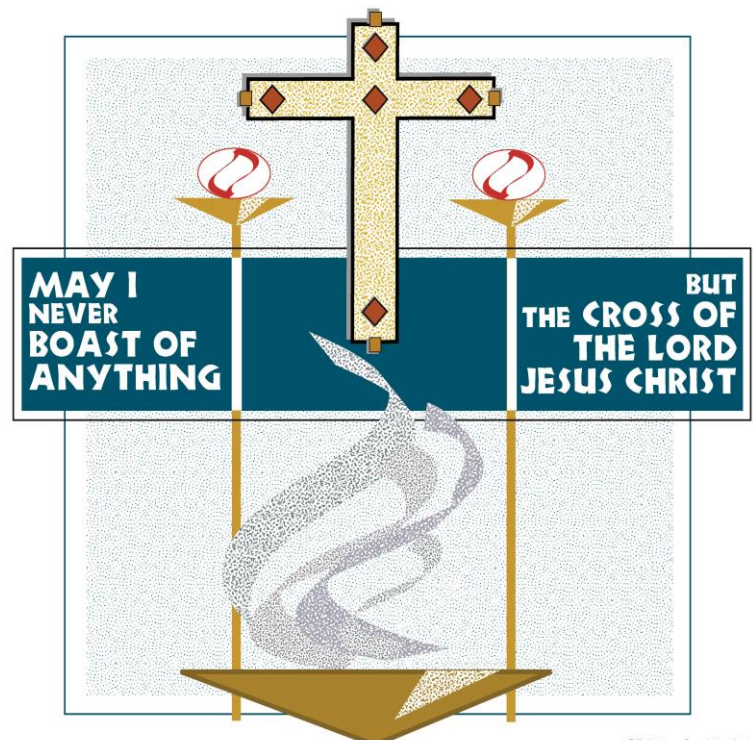

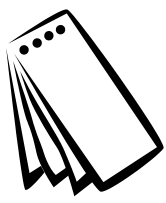

Because class size is limited to 20 persons, several sessions will be scheduled to accommodate all those who wish to attend. This training is especially recommended for all of our ushers, ministers, and anyone who may be in a situation where CPR would be beneficial. Although this is not for certification, participants will receive the necessary training needed to perhaps one day help to save a life.



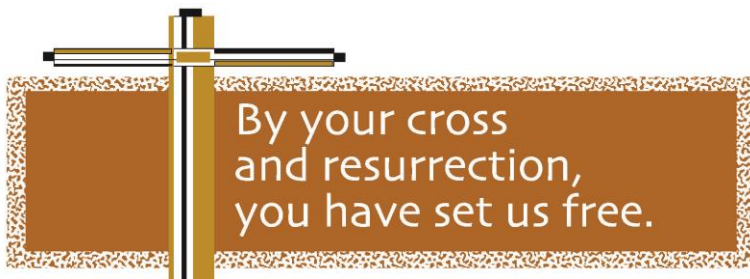
