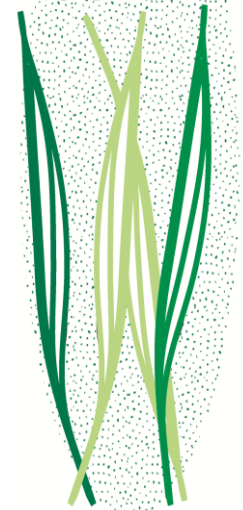

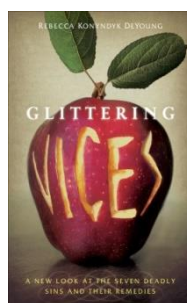

### 12<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL REGIONAL DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

St. Ignatius Loyola Parish (339 N. Maple Avenue in Kingston) will host the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday on the Second Sunday of Easter, April 8 (previously held at St. Maria Goretti Parish in Laflin).
